

**TOWN OF BROOKLET
CALLED MEETING
MAY 18, 2010
MINUTES**

1. **CALL MEETING TO ORDER:** Mayor Grooms
2. **INVOCATION:** Mayor Grooms
3. **MR. ROBINSON WITH SOUTHERN LINK WIRELESS, HAS LOOKED AT PROPERTY OWNED BY THE CITY OF BROOKLET AND IS INTERESTED IN PLACING A TOWER ON THE TWELVE ACRES WHERE THE SCOUT HUT IS LOCATED OR ON THE ONE ACREA ON RAILROAD STREET. MR. ROBINSON IS SEEKING APPROVAL OF AN OPTION TO LEASE FROM COUNCIL.**

Councilman Stanoff recommends using the property where the scout hut is for something more useful for the Town of Brooklet, like a Community Center; Councilman Orr would like for the Council to look at the aesthetics in terms of the tower being so tall and creating an eyesore for the Town of Brooklet.

Councilman Orr made a motion to table this discussion until further notice with the exception of the scout hut not being an option for the use of the communication tower; motion was seconded by Councilman Davis and passed with all eyes.

Ms. Belle will contact Mr. Robinson and ask him to attend a town meeting to provide more information to the Mayor and Council about the Southern Link Communication Tower.

4. **DISCUSSION AND MOTION OF PAVING SOUTHEASTERN TIRE SERVICE PARKING LOT WHILE ELLIS WOOD PAVING COMPANY IS IN TOWN.**
